Le FRENCH DESIGN 100

January 2024 — 3rd awards ceremony

On January 19th, the conference area of the Maison&Objet exhibition hosted furniture professionals and members of the international press to find out more about the winning projects of the 3rd edition of Le FRENCH DESIGN 100 Awards, a unique competition that highlights the international reputation of French design expertise.

The members of the international jury, chaired by Laurent Le Bon (Centre Pompidou) and Hervé Lemoine (Mobilier national and honorary president of Le FD100), praised the quality of the winning projects - interiors, decorative objects and furniture.

Bernard Reybier and Jean-Paul Bath, chairperson and CEO respectively of Le FRENCH DESIGN, and Arnaud Visse, chairperson of French Furniture (AF), attended this event, highly anticipated by the entire industry to which it pays tribute, a wonderful pool of designers and manufacturers whose talent is universally acclaimed.





Le FD100, the unifying force in the furniture industry

The previous two editions of Le FD100 brought together players in the interiors sector in venues steeped in history and symbolism. **In 2019, the Musée des Arts Décoratifs in the Louvre Palace**, with the support of the Minister of Culture and the patronage of Philippe Starck, hosted the first edition of the prize.

The next, in January 2022, was held **under the distinguished patronage of Emmanuel MACRON, President of the French Republic, who welcomed the winners to the Elysée Palace** for an evening that was truly special in more ways than one. The event was unprecedented: by allowing French design to be celebrated at the Elysée Palace for the very first time, Le FD100 initiated a key moment propelled by all the players in the sector.

In the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic, a chaotic and uncertain period, Le FD100 symbolised a new impetus and marked the emergence of a reunifying ceremony.



The international market craves French savoir-faire

The growing number of entries received (**570 projects**) for this third edition of the awards **testifies to its increased visibility and prestige**. A unique feature of Le FD100 is that it is the only prize honouring the joint efforts of all the interior furnishings industry members abroad. The 2024 edition paints an impressive map of the international market's appetite for French expertise, with no fewer than 50 countries represented.



"We feel it's vital to highlight this international influence, to showcase the full range of French expertise in creations that are sometimes produced far from home. Our traditions, our savoir-faire, our curiosity about others and our daring spirit are the driving force behind a growing demand", enthuses Jean-Paul Bath.

FIRST COLLABORATION WITH THE CENTRE POMPIDOU

President of the Centre Pompidou, Laurent Le Bon chairs the Le FD100 2024 jury. The institution, loved by French people and tourists alike, has over 8,000 works by 900 designers in its collections, and actively supports the contemporary design scene.

The collaboration continues thanks to Hervé Lemoine’s role as Honorary Chairman of the 2024 jury.

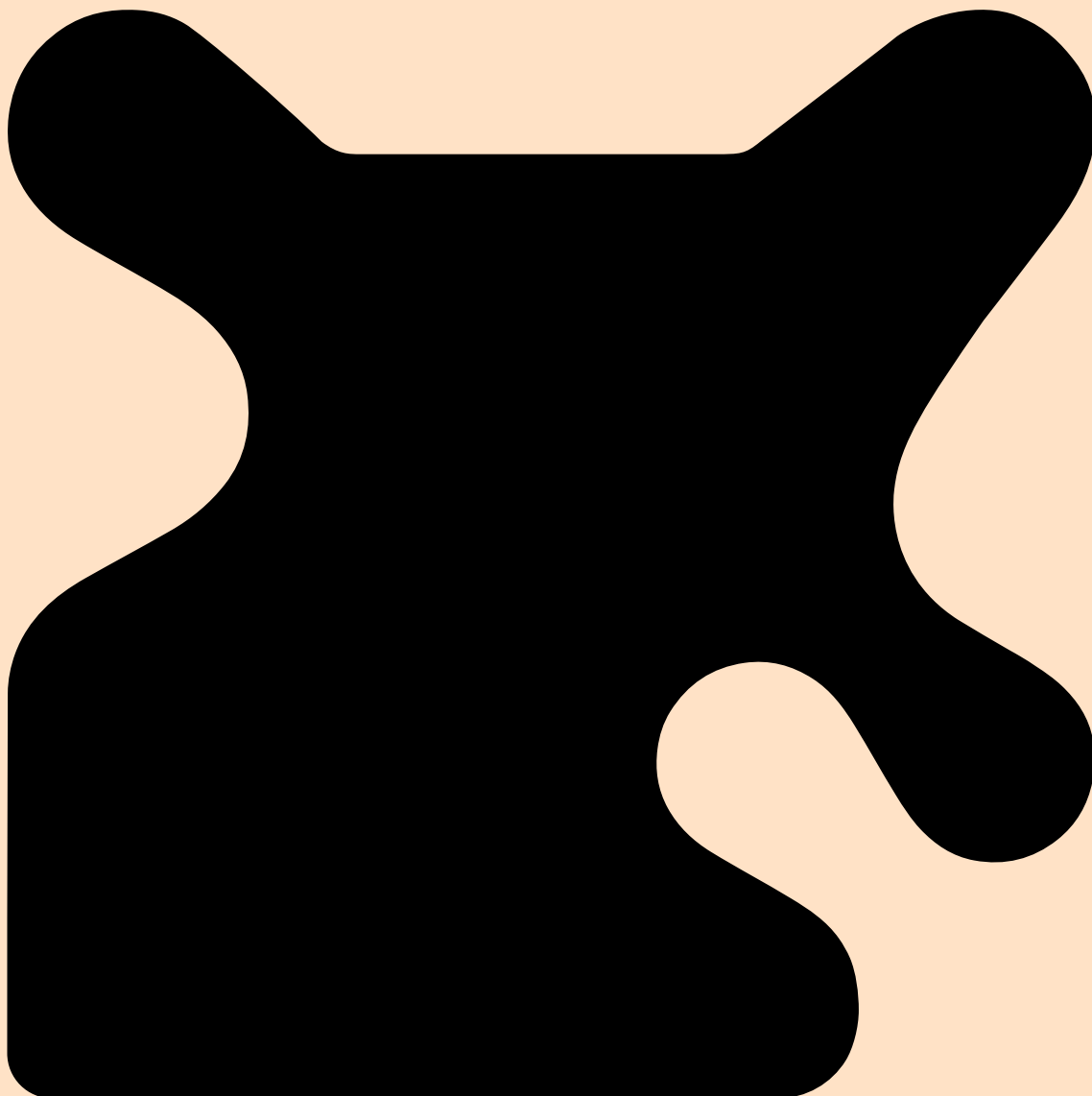
